Block 16 Urban Food Hall (The Cosmopolitan)

TikTok famous viral food hall featuring a collection of extremely famous restaurants in their originating city/state. There is something for everyone ranging from rice bowls at Bang Bar by Momofuku, Nashville-style chicken from Hattie B's Hot Chicken, and sandwiches from Lardo's.

48th and Crepe (New York-New York)

Whether you're craving something sweet or savory, they've got you covered with made-to-order crepes, waffles, and breakfast classics. The setting is casual and charming.

Bouchon Bakery (The Venetian)

Beautiful bakery setting with excellent croissants, macarons, and quality espresso.

Glass Bar (Planet Hollywood)

Perfect spot for pre- or post-show drinks, featuring craft cocktails, spirits, and TV screens to catch sports or soak in the vibe. The sleek lounge features thousands of crystal prisms, mirrored columns, and ombré lighting.

Mon Ami Gabi (Paris LV)

Classic French bistro fare with a view. Steak frites, roast chicken, onion soup, mussels. The patio overlooks the Strip and the Bellagio fountains, adding a memorable backdrop. Prices are mid-range, casual but still special.

The Peppermill Restaurant & Fireside Lounge (LV Boulevard)

A Vegas institution. If you want something unique, nostalgic, with big portions and a fun, vintage vibe — this is it. More casual, but iconic. Great whatever the time of day and has character.

PISCES Bar & Seafare (Wynn)

This new Mediterranean seafood restaurant lends an elevated coastal experience: fresh fish, shareable platters, and beautifully crafted pastas, with an ocean-inspired setting overlooking the Lake of Dreams.

Sparrow + Wolf

Inventive American cuisine with global flair — a cozy gem just off the LV Strip. Think seasonal produce, locally sourced meats, bold cocktails, and a style that balances technical craft with approachability.

Tacos El Gordo

A long standing Vegas institution known for authentic Tijuana-style tacos is inexpensive with consistent good customer service, conveniently located on the strip.

Via Via (Venetian Food Hall)

A new food hall that replaces the old food court at the Venetian. It has a mix of trendy spots — Nashville hot chicken (Howlin' Ray's), tacos, good sandwiches, ramen. Good if your group likes variety.
